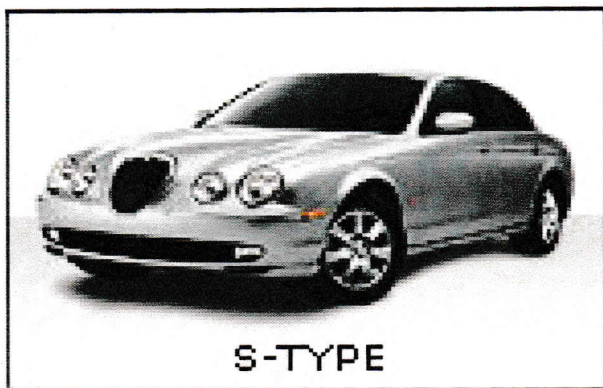

## October Rallye

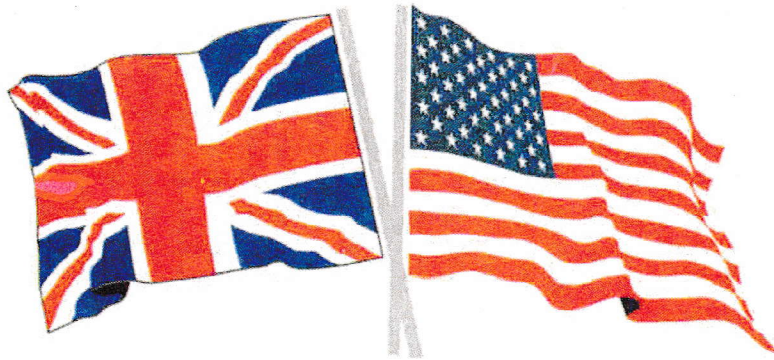

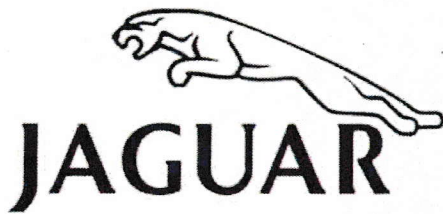
In closing, I would like to apologize to the last club director who got sea sick aboard "The Moshulu" during our celebration.

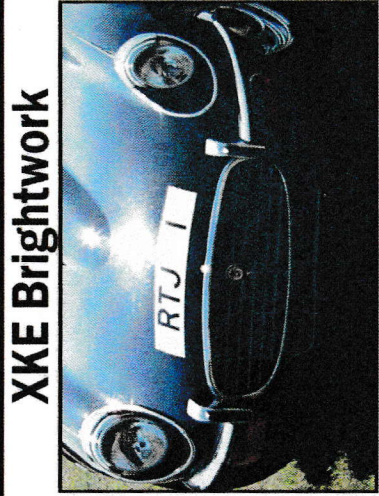

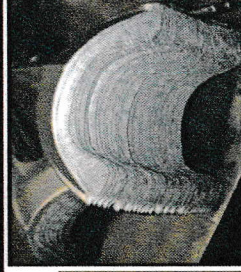

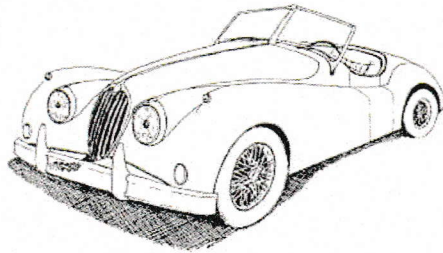
